SUMMER CAMP COUNSELOR

St. Helena Unified School District is accepting applications for summer camp counselors to work at the Aquatic Center. There are four (4) positions available and they are all temporary, seasonal, at-will positions only.

General Duties: Under the direction of the Director of Aquatics and Facility Use, the camp counselor is responsible for the care of a group of children age 6 to 12 years old; lead daily camp activities; supervise junior camp counselors; and provide moral leadership by being a positive role model. The camp counselor will plan and lead recreational activities in a safe, fun and innovative manner, accompany assigned group of campers to each activity and stay with them, teach and supervise campers. Perform other related duties as required.

Qualifications: Current certification is First Aid and CPR (infant/child and adult), or able to become certified before camp session begins. Minimum age is 15 to apply for this position. *Must attend all camp orientation sessions and work the full nine weeks of day camp.*
